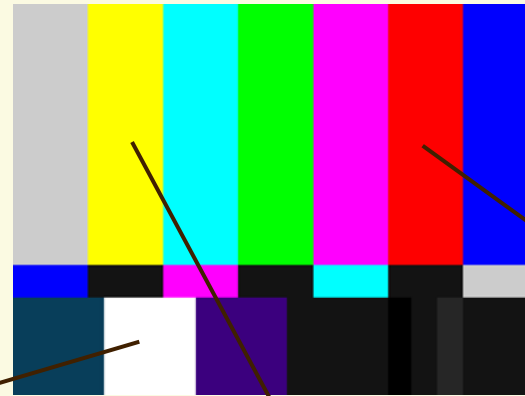

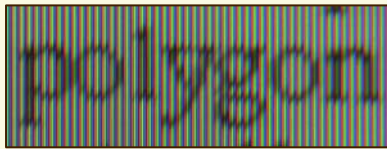

SMPTE color bars

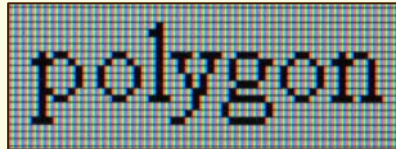

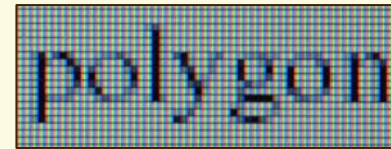

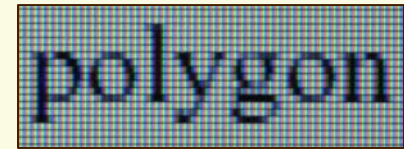
integral pixel font
